Year 13 - End of Year Arrangements and Information

Dear Students/Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to you to outline some important information as we enter the final few weeks of teaching and assessment of Year 13 students. It has been a disrupted year with many challenges to overcome and we would like to take this opportunity to say that we are proud of the way our students have conducted themselves. They have demonstrated significant strength of character and resilience throughout.

Our final day of teaching and assessment for Year 13 will be Thursday 27th May 2021. However, we would like to welcome all students back on the morning of Friday 28th May 2021 for our Leavers Assembly. This will take place during period one with students departing immediately after. The assembly is an opportunity for students to mark the end of their Sixth Form journey, collect their leavers hoodies, and say goodbye to fellow students and staff.

Following the 27th May, staff will continue to mark, moderate and formulate the “Teacher Assessed Grades” in line with school policy and JCQ guidance. Students may have sat assessments prior to the 27th May for which they have not received any feedback/scores.
